## NIMBUS PROJECT

### **Central Tender 01-2022 for the Addition of Services to the Government Digital Marketplace Opening Additional Categories – Tender Administrator's Updates and Clarifications**

Greetings,

1. On December 20, 2023, the Government Procurement Administration (hereinafter – the "**Tender Administrator**") issued the third publication of Central Tender 01-2022 for the Addition of Services to the Government Digital Marketplace (hereinafter – the "**Tender**").
2. The Tender Administrator is now publishing an updated version of the tender documents and the Tender Administrator's answers to clarification questions and comments that were received. The current version of the tender documents includes several clarifications and updates. All the changes that were made are indicated by track changes. Below are several key points:

#### **2.1 Nimbus Service Agreement**

2.1.1 The Service Agreement has been separated from Booklet No. 1 of the tender documents. The Service Agreement has now been published as a separate file and is marked as Appendix 7 to the Bid Booklet (Booklet No. 2).

2.1.2 A bidder that did not sign the Service Agreement in the framework of the Tender's previous publications, **is required to submit the Service Agreement at the time of submission of the bid for the Tender**. This agreement should be submitted as a separate file, signed by the bidder's authorized signatory/ies as set out in section 2.1.9.1.2 of the Bid Booklet.

2.1.3 Please note that as part of the changes made, only the bidder's signature is required on the Service Agreement.

2.2 **Deployment of the service in the Israeli region** – As part of the changes made, the period of time defined for the deployment of the service in Israel has been extended. As specified in section 3.6.3.1, it will be possible to deploy a service in the Israeli region **within 12 months from the date of announcement of the service as a winner in the Tender**.

3. Please be advised that no changes were made to the Manufacturer's Statement.



4. For the ease of usage, the documents have been published on the tender page both in a copy with track changes and in a clean copy. **Care should be taken at all times to use only the updated tender documents.** All the documents can be viewed on the dedicated page opened for the third publication on the website of the Government Procurement Administration (hereinafter – the "Tender Page") at the link: <https://mr.gov.il/ilgstorefront/en/p/4000580581>.
5. Please note that the deadline for submitting bids for the Tender remains unchanged: **Tuesday, March 26, 2024 (26.03.24), at 13:00 (Israel Standard Time).**
6. All the clarifications and changes detailed above form an integral part of the requirements and conditions set out in the tender documents.
