



Request For Information

For the preparation of a Tender for the Design, Construction, Operation and Maintenance of a Treatment Facility for and Removal of Groundwater Contaminants from the IMI site at Ramat-Ha'sharon

Pursuant to the provisions of **Article 14A** of the **Mandatory Tenders Regulations, 5753-1993**, the **Israeli governmental Authority for water and sewage via its Water Quality Division ("WA")** hereby publicly invites local and foreign entities to participate in this Request for Information process. This process is aimed at providing the WA with information towards the preparation of a tender for the Design, Construction, Commissioning, Operation and Maintenance of a Facility for Treatment and Removal of Groundwater Contaminants such as Perchlorate, RDX, HMX and Chromates from the vicinity of the Israel Military Industry at Ramat Ha'sharon.

1. **Short Summary of the Information requested¹:**

- (a) Responder's profile;
- (b) Responder's past experience in treatment of groundwater contaminants;
- (c) Framework of the projects participated by the Responder;
- (d) Project description: owner, location, stages and duration of each, objectives, implemented technology, financial aspects, source of inlet and composition, pollutant inlet and outlet concentration, flow rates, current operation status.
- (e) Composition of the respective contractor, members and key personnel.
- (f) The WA is requesting the aforesaid information to be focused on potential and feasible technologies involving biological treatment of perchlorate and/or nitrate.

Accordingly this RFI process shall not limit the WA in any manner including with regard to the advancement of the tender, the remediation project or the manner of their implementation as deemed fit by the WA.
- (f) This RFI process and RFI Responses shall not constitute any right whatsoever of the Responder. Nor shall the RFI process and responses thereto constitute an obligation or commencement of the WA to engage with any Responder or derogate from any right and authority reserved to the WA under the law and the RFI document.
- (g) The WA shall be entitled to make use of the information all as provided under the Request for Information.
