Situated at the gateway of Jerusalem, The ICC Jerusalem International Convention Center (ICC) is overlooking the city's panoramic landscape. This impressive venue is Israel's largest convention center and has hosted many presidential receptions, international exhibitions by distinguished artists, important industry-related conventions and spectacular performances. Throughout the years, ICC has demonstrated professionalism and reliability. The venue's reputation has been augmented by its professional staff, as well as, its efficient logistical support and capabilities.

The Venue

The mega ICC complex, with its 27 custom-designed halls provides a tailored solution for any kind of event including conferences, congresses, trade fairs, seminars, symposia, social encounters, business events, and private events. The huge space and scores of halls can be divided according to every and each client requirements offering great flexibility for hosting 100 up to 20,000 participants. The venue's abundance of entrances and exits facilitate the concurrent occurrence of a single large-scale event, alongside subdivision of smaller groups. There are 12,000 square meters (130,000 square feet) of exhibition space and halls spread over ten different spaces on two levels. Large parking lots are adjacent to the Center, including covered parking.

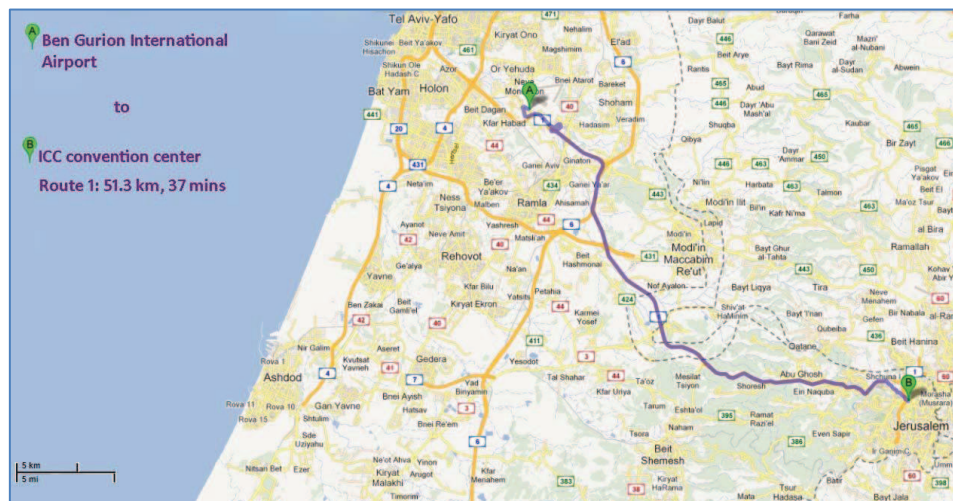

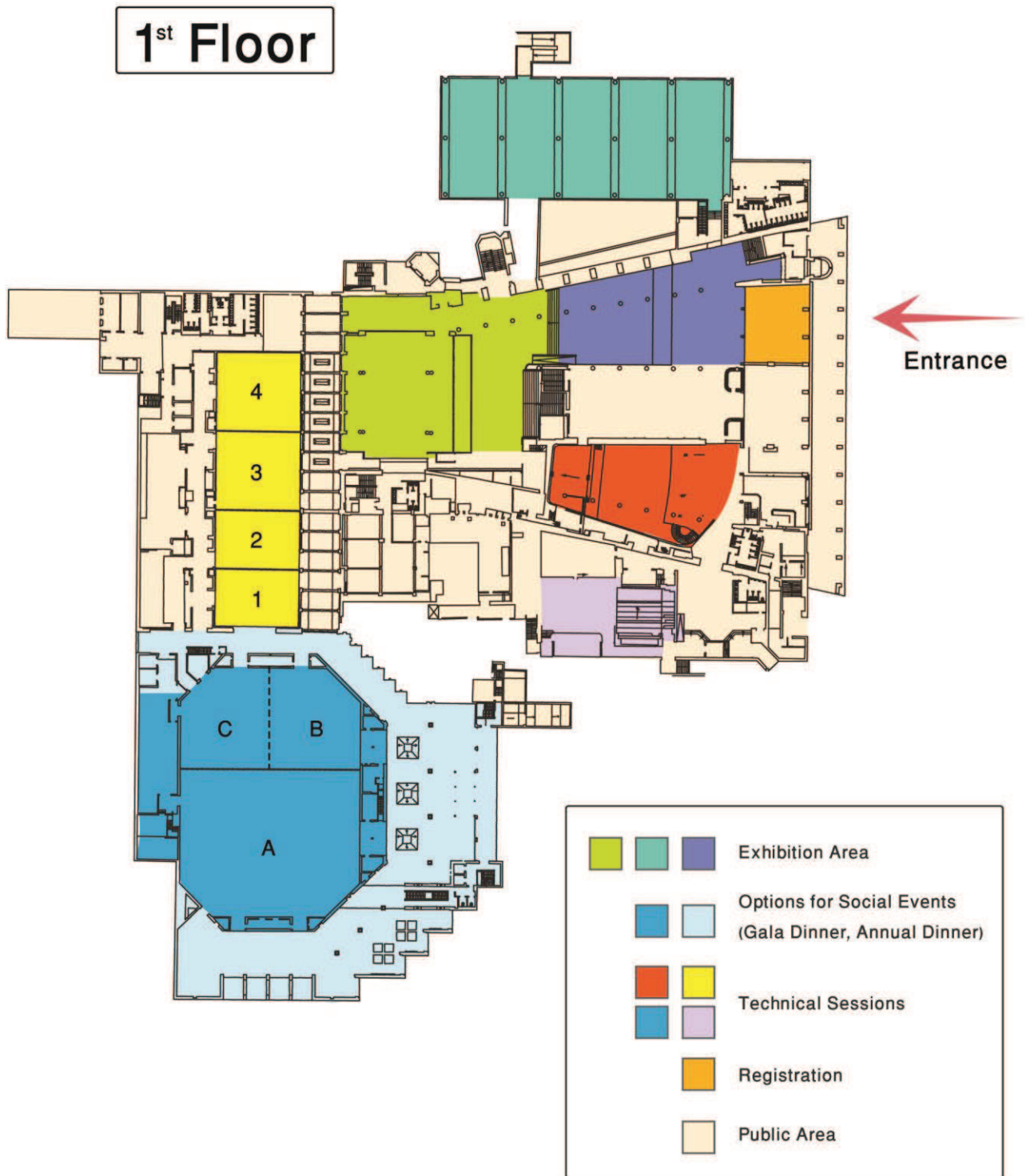

ICC Halls Layout

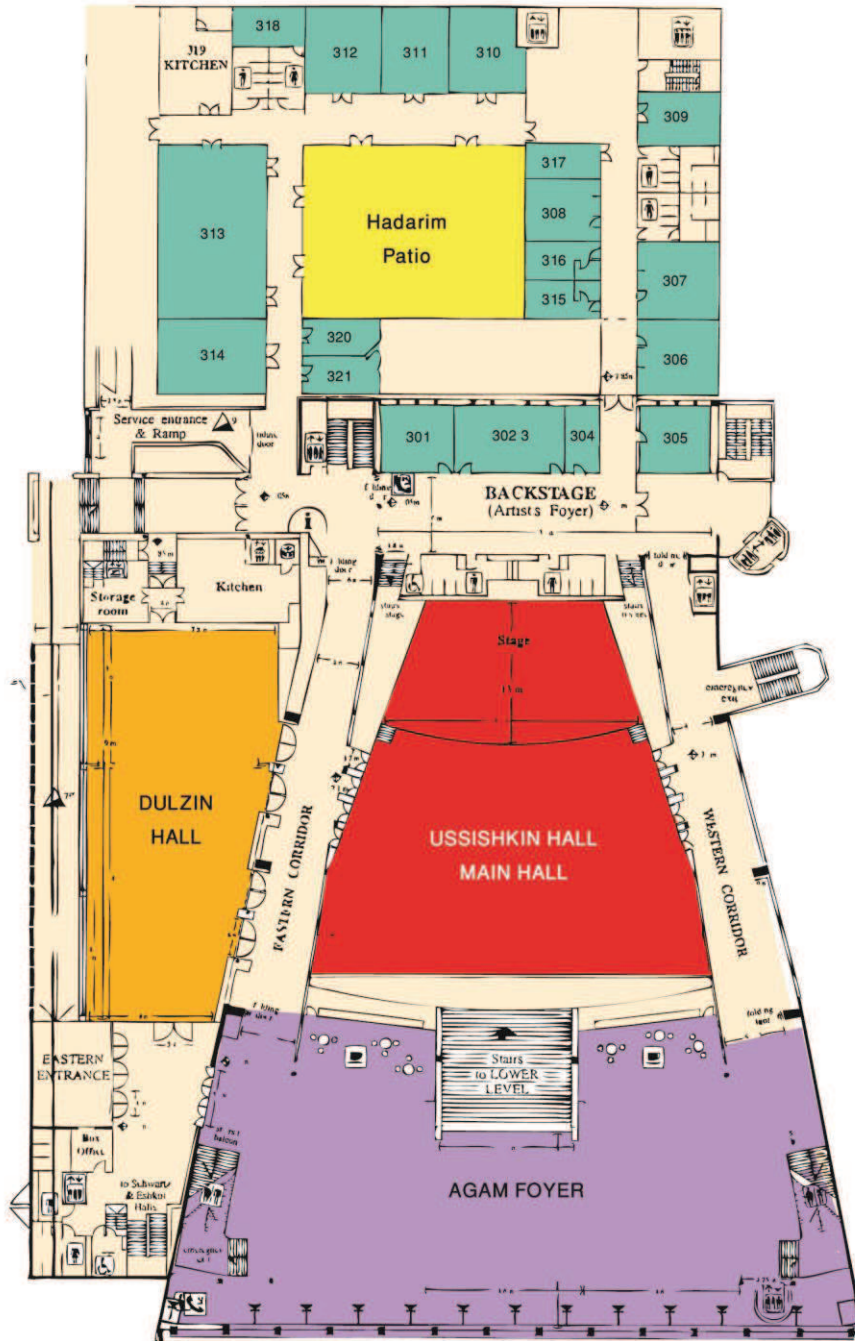
Spacious and Flexible

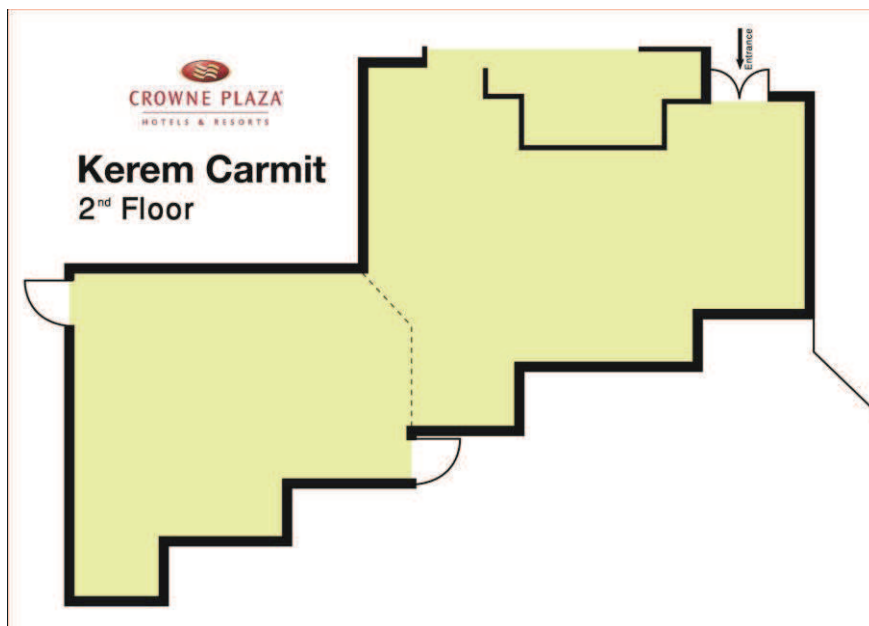
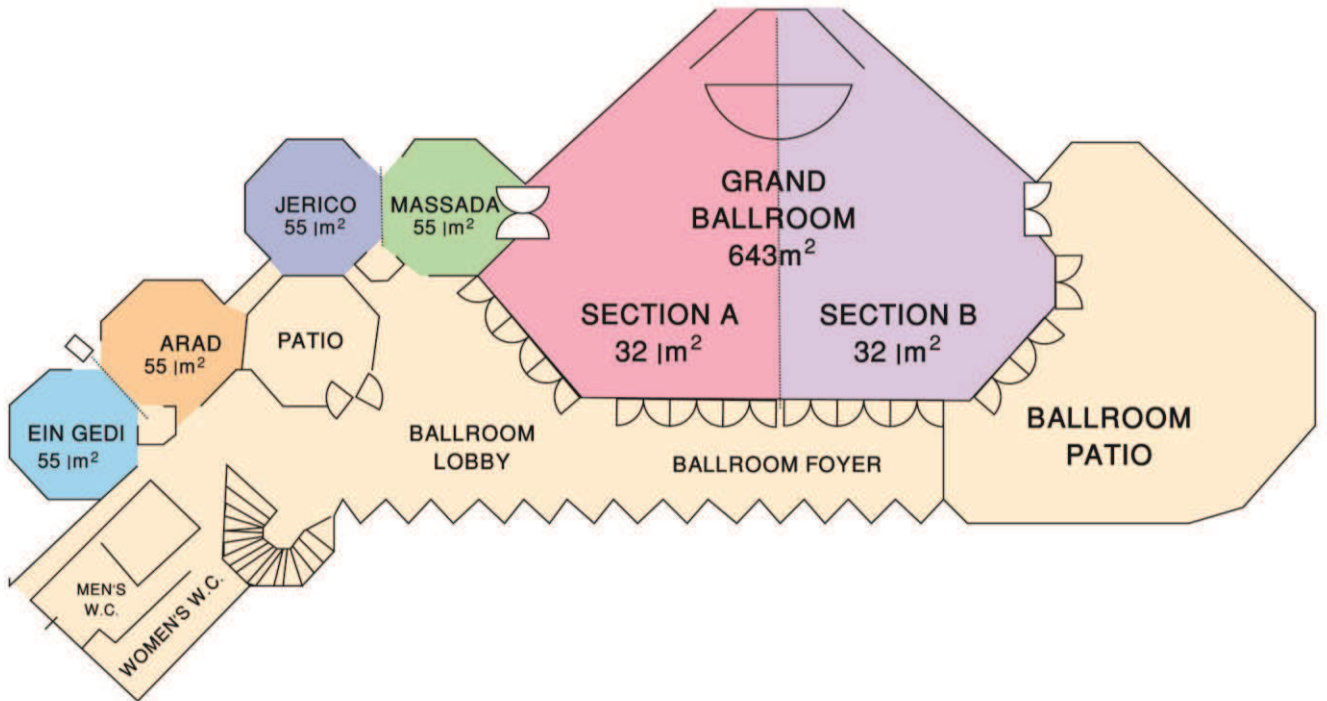

Teddy Hall (A,B,C,D in 1st Floor Diagram)

Building and Occupancy

The spacious Teddy Hall can host 1,000 people seated at round tables, and 2,000 people in receptions, conferences and buffet-style meals. It has an immense flexibility and can be divided by acoustic partitions into four separate halls of varying sizes and capacities, in accordance with the events requirements. The open areas and entrance foyer, surrounding the hall on three sides, are designed for registration, receptions and exhibitions, as well as rest and meeting areas between conference sessions. These areas can hold up to 1,000 people. **Teddy halls are suitable for IISL Annual Dinner, IAC Gala Dinner, Young Professional Programmes Sessions and Student Cocktail Reception.**

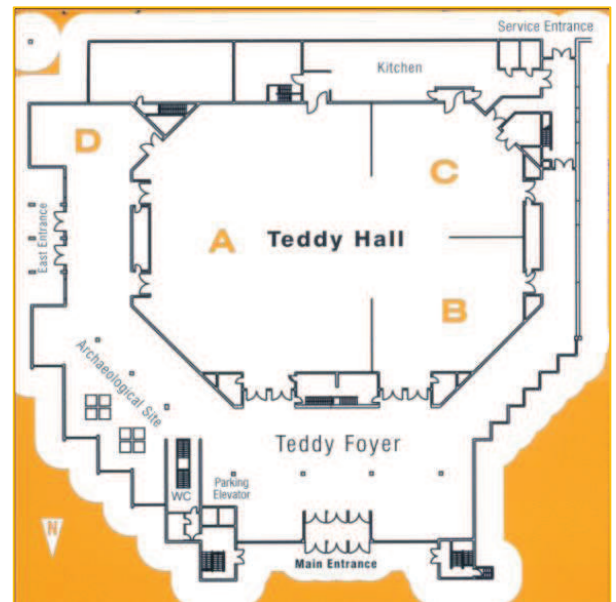

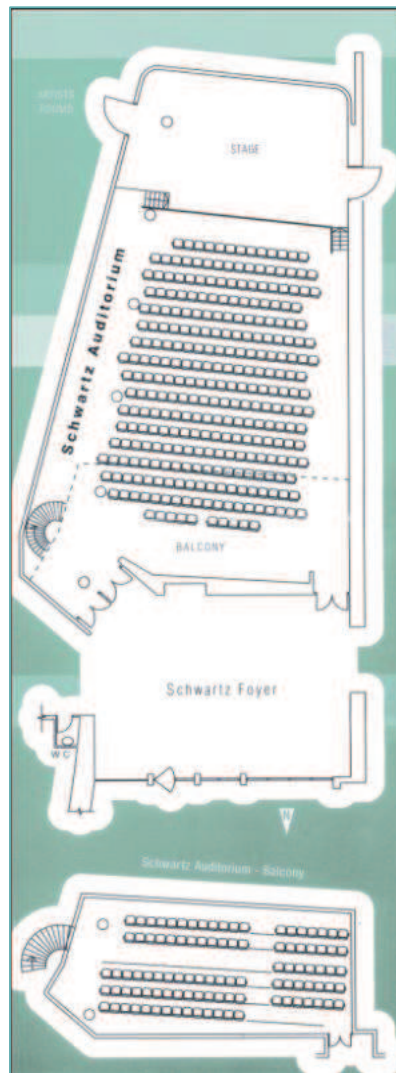
The Schwartz Auditorium (1st Floor Diagram)

The Schwartz Auditorium is located near the Convention Centre's Entrance Hall, across from the Coffee Shop. It is used for hosting lectures and panel discussions, shows, movies, multimedia productions, plays, ceremonies, conventions, and press conferences. At the Auditorium's front there is the stage with a presentation screen. The Auditorium contains 390 permanent seats, positioned on two levels. Access to the balcony is via the rounded stairs. The hall is suitable for **Technical Sessions**.

Schwartz Auditorium Maximum Occupancy: 390 people

(Hall – 289 seats, Balcony – 101 seats)

Stage dimensions are: Depth: 7.45m, Width: 11m.

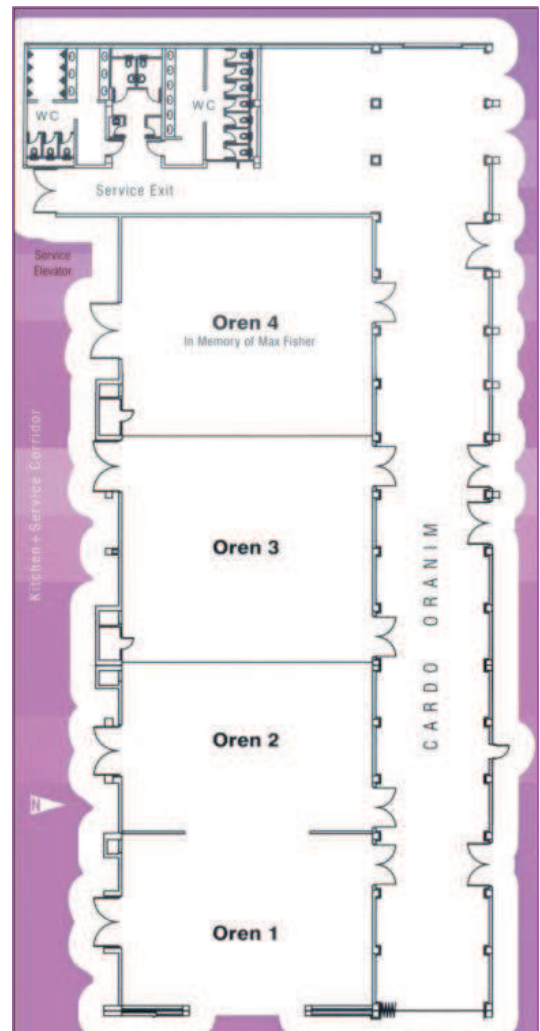


Oranim Halls (1,2,3,4 in 1st Floor Diagram)

Flexibility in structure and functionality

The Oranim wing is considered one of the most elegant and attractive sites for conferences. The wing composed of four halls, which can be joined into a big hall or used individually. Its modular structure allows it to function as a large conference hall with 790 seats, or as a wide scale complex for exhibitions, especially the kind containing large display stands and exhibits. Acoustic wooden partitions divide the four halls and impart a warm atmosphere. Wall hangings, low ceilings and dimmer lighting amplify the pleasant and intimate atmosphere of this wing. The halls are suitable for **Technical Sessions**.

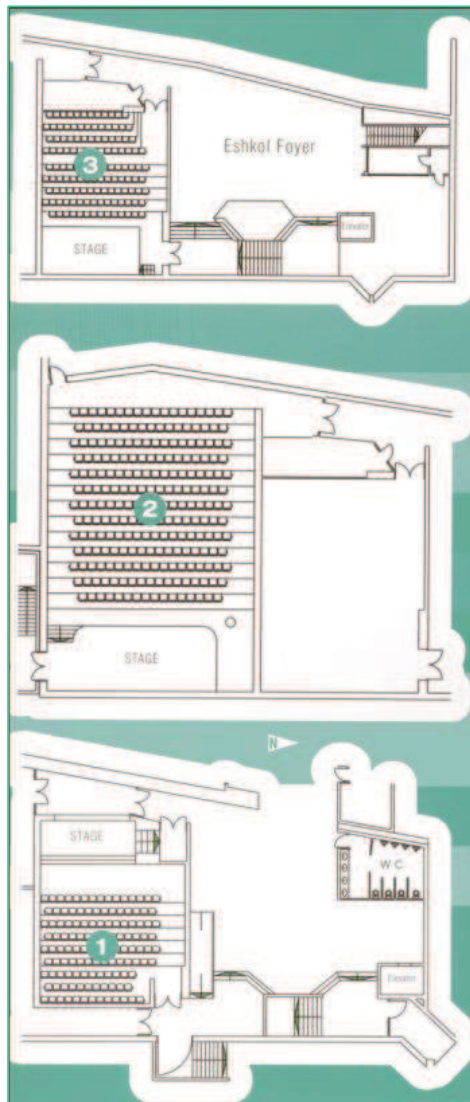
The Eshkol Auditoriums (1st Floor Diagram)

The Eshkol Auditorium complex is comprised of 3 Halls that differ in size and shape. All the Halls contain permanently fixed seats, a stage, an exhibition screen and adjoining screening room. The halls are suitable for **Technical Sessions**.

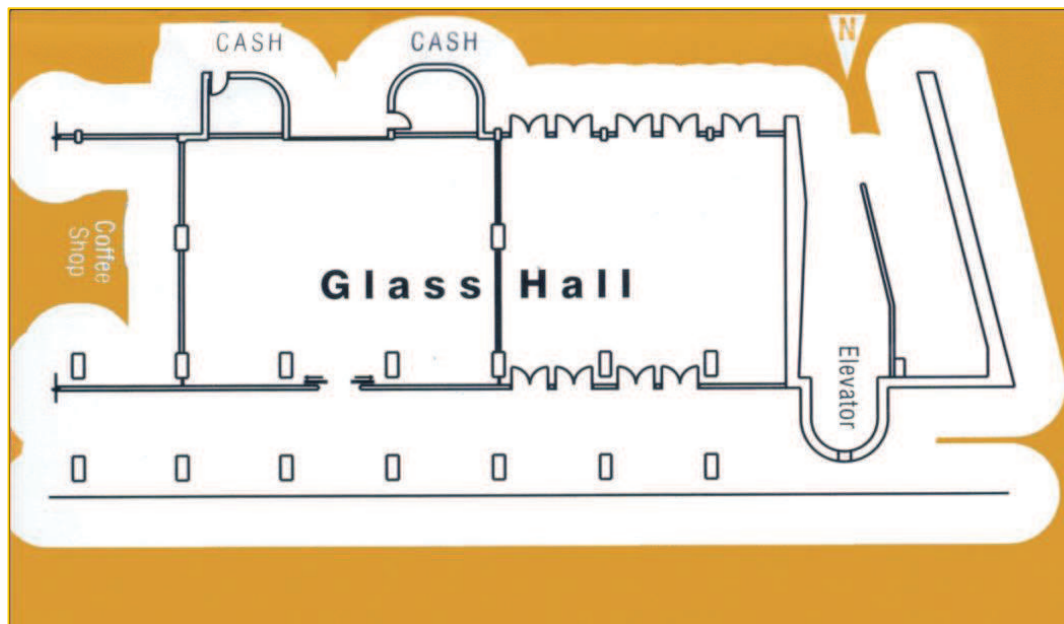
The Glass Hall (1st Floor Diagram) – Registration

The Glass hall is the main entrance to the convention centre.

The space is vast and ideal for **Registration**, Optional for additional exhibition area.

Exhibition & Posters Boards Area

The exhibition area will be located at the Entrance Lobby, Pincus Hall, Exhibition Hall and Agam Foyer (total of 3,200 sqm). Should there be need for additional exhibition space, it is possible to construct a tent of 1,000 sqm at the entrance to the ICC Glass Hall.

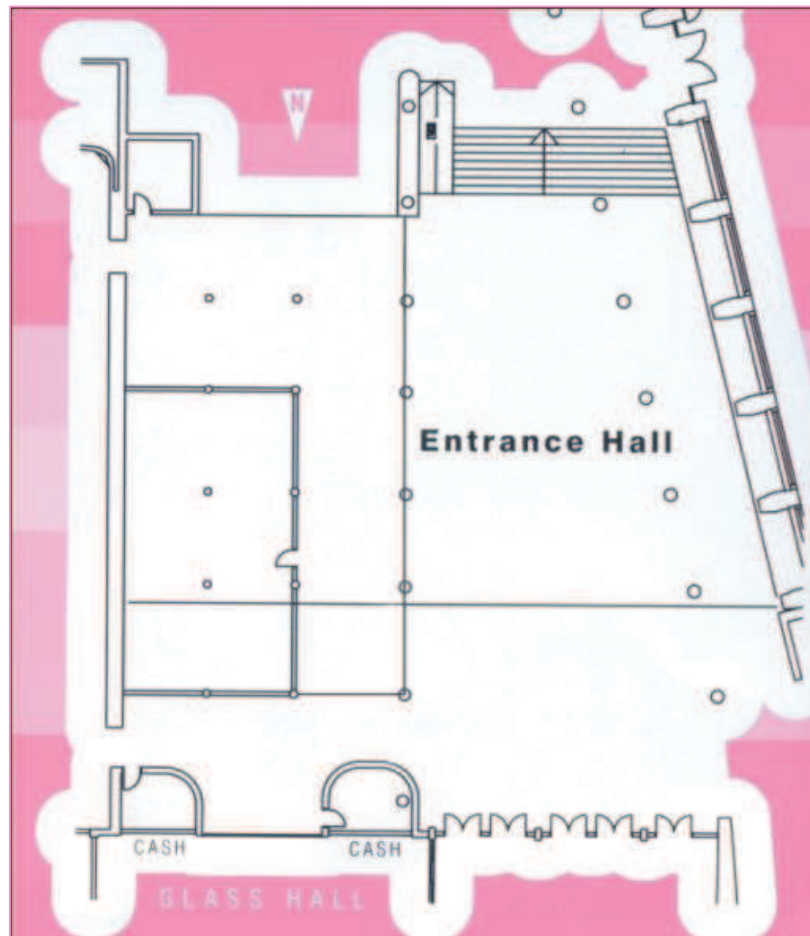
The entire exhibition area will be divided for **Food Courts, Internet Café, IAC Exhibition, Students Exhibition, Poster Boards and Accompanying Persons' area.**

Entrance Lobby (1st Floor Diagram)

The elegant and spacious entrance lobby is the central meeting point of the Convention Center. This hall is particularly suitable for exhibitions, cocktail parties, coffee breaks and rest periods.

Entrance Lobby Size: 550 Square Meters

Maximum Occupancy: 800 people



Pincus Hall (1st Floor Diagram)

Along with the Entrance Hall and Lounge, Pincus Hall creates a concurrent and open territory, especially good for exhibitions. The hall will be modified into an open space without walls.

Pincus Hall Size: 427 Square Meters

Maximum Occupancy: 600 people

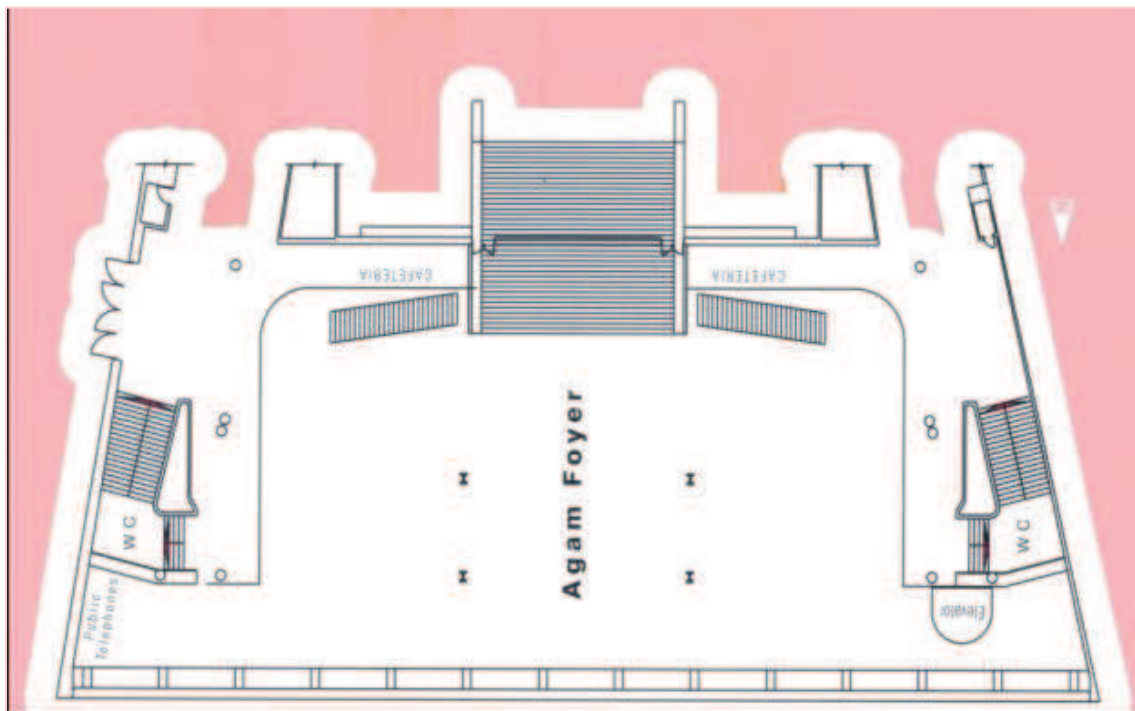


Agam Foyer (2nd Floor Diagram)

Situated up the stairs from Pincus Hall, Agam Foyer is the ideal location for hosting additional **Exhibition, Posters and Accompanying Person Area**. The Foyer is used as an entrance to the Ossishkin Auditorium. Its large windows, standing from the ceiling to the floor all across the Hall, provide the most amazing view of Jerusalem in the daylight, and at night time -the spectacular lights of the city.

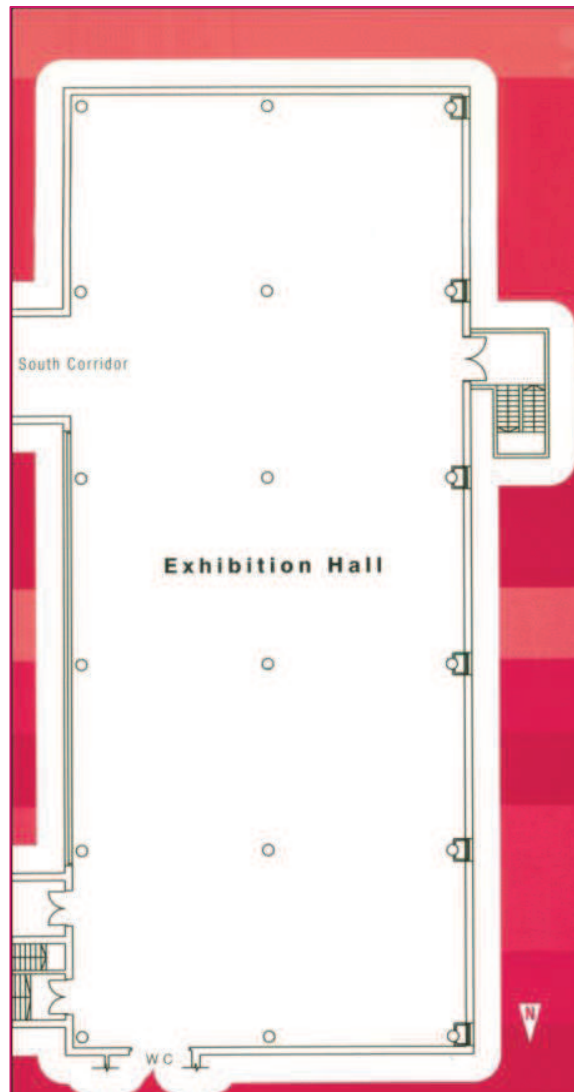


Exhibition Hall (1st Floor Diagram)

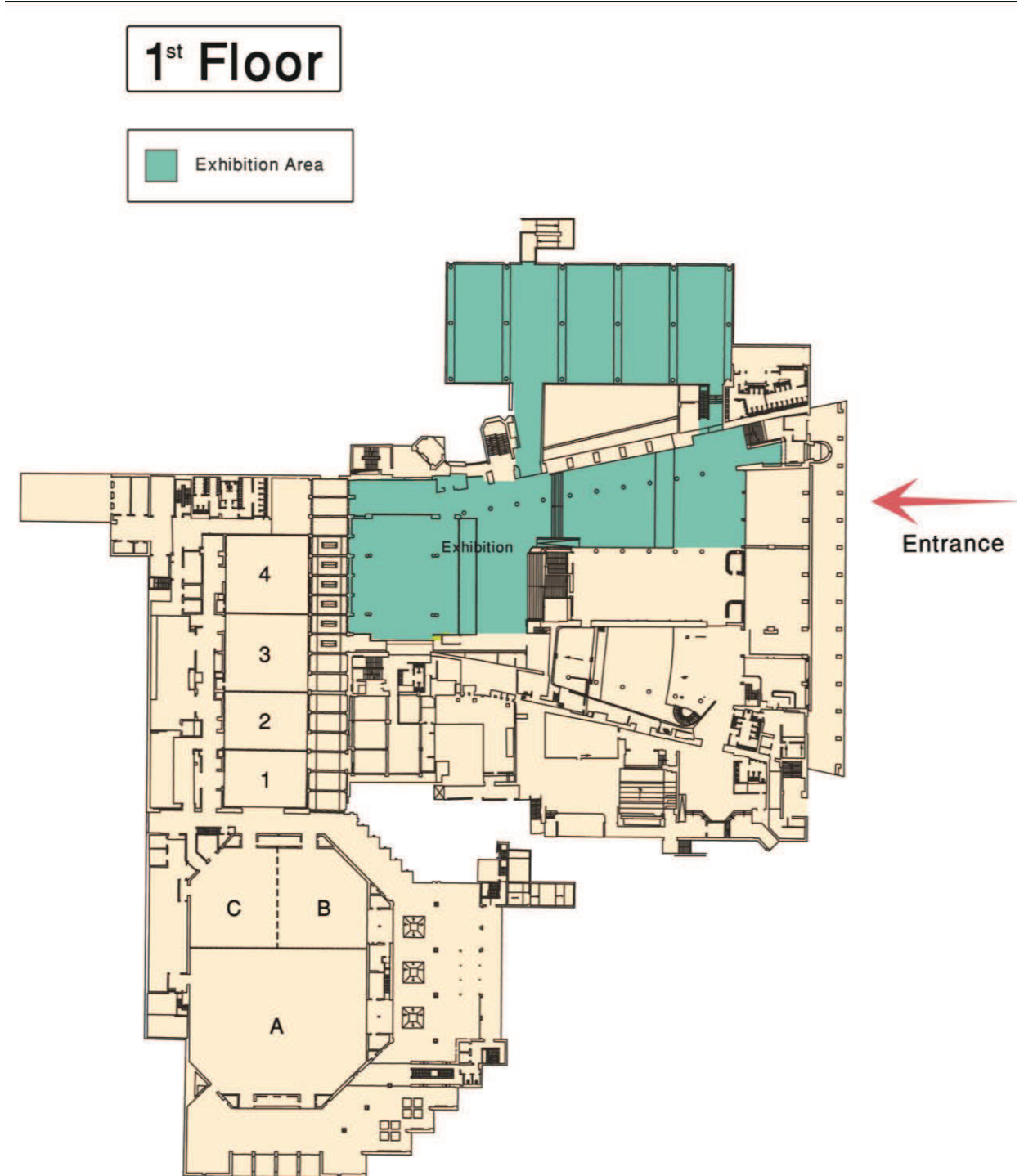
Perfectly suitable for **Exhibitions, Posters, Internet Cafe**, and diverse assemblies. Its vast space is ideal for exhibitions that stand alone, or, are part of a convention. In the rectangular Hall, one can cater full service or a buffet, per choice or requirements. There is also the option to enter the Hall from the separate entrance at the northern front of the Convention Centre.

Maximum Occupancy: 1,400 people

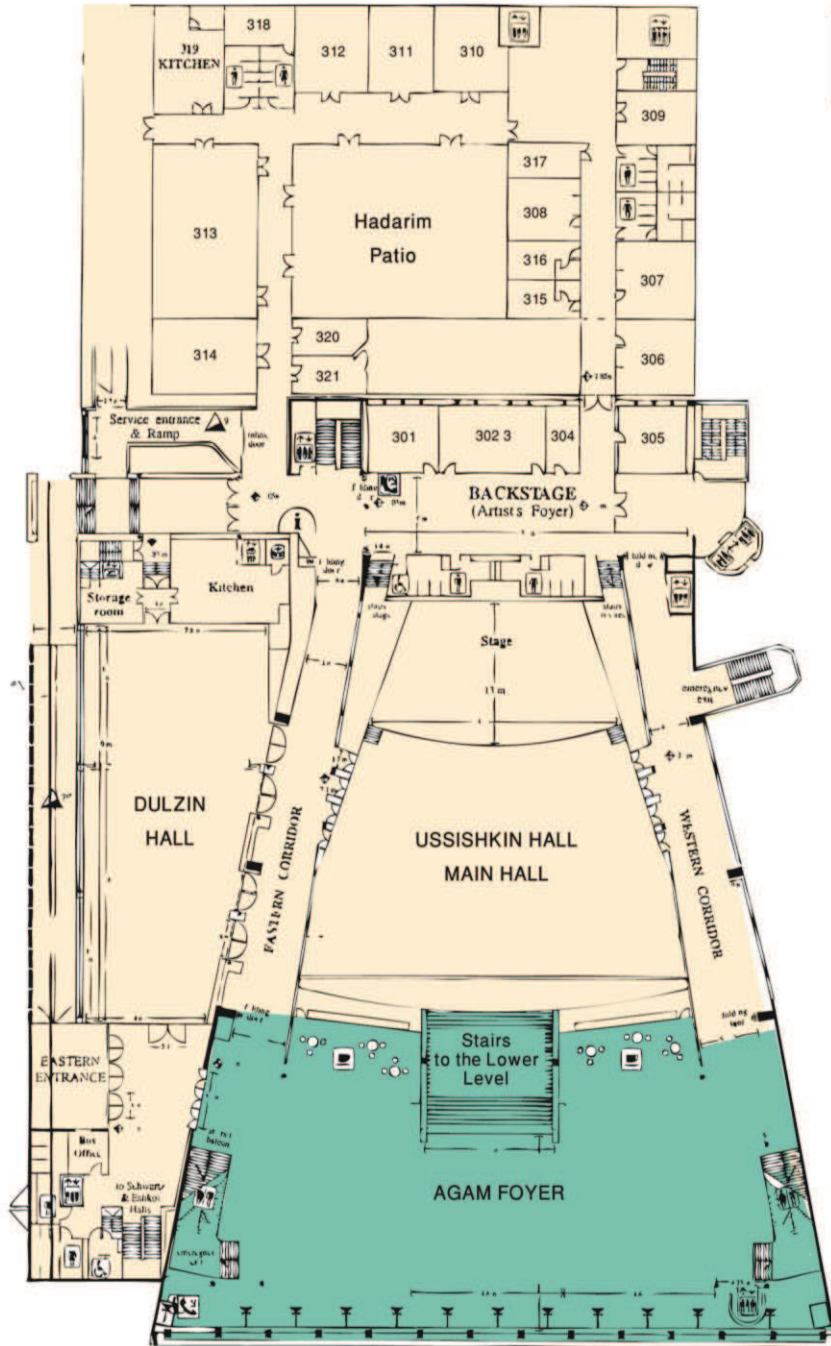


ICC Exhibition Space

Exhibition Area

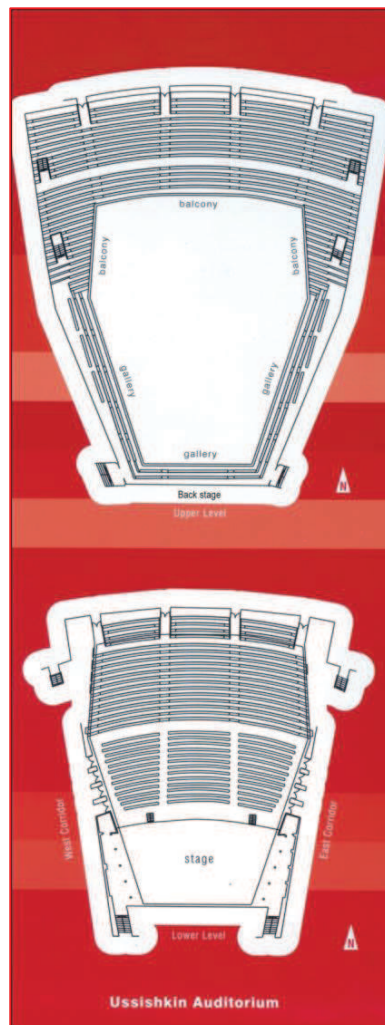


The Ussishkin Auditorium (2nd Floor Diagram)

With its spaciousness, first rate acoustics, state-of-the-art equipment and the finest support services available, the Ussishkin auditorium provides the perfect solution for hosting large scale conventions. The auditorium is suitable to host **The Opening Ceremony, Welcome Reception, Plenary and Highlight Lecture Sessions.**

Ussishkin Auditorium Maximum Occupancy: 3,000 people
Stage Depth: 13 Meters, Stage width: 23 Meters, Height: 11 Meters.

Special equipment and facilities: 30 monitors (20 electric), one stage, three-phase electric power outlets, three translation cubicles, recording and broadcasting studios for radio, TV stations for live broadcasting.



Dulzin Hall (2nd Floor Diagram)

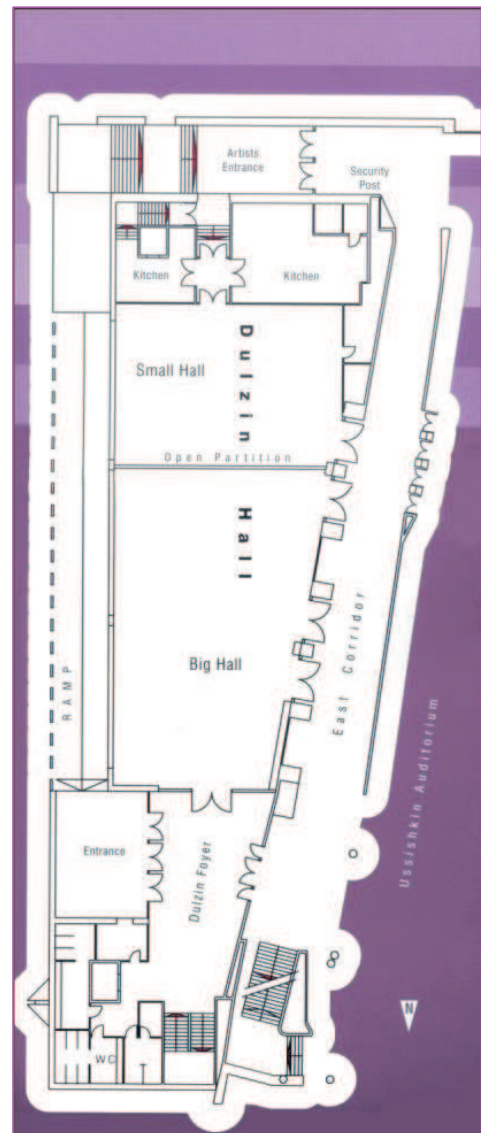
Dulzin Hall is located next to the auditorium and Agam Lounge. An acoustic barrier enables the division of the hall into two separate spaces that differ in size and capacity, so that it may be modified to the nature and size of the event. The uniqueness of Dulzin Hall is evident and reflected in the large glass windows that enable its visitors to enjoy an aired, lit hall that overlooks an amazing view of Jerusalem. Rolling curtains enable to darken the room, if necessary.

Dulzing Big Hall is suitable for **Special Purpose Room Workshops**.

Dulzing Small Hall is suitable for **Technical Sessions**.

Hadarim Patio (2nd Floor Diagram)

The Hadarim Courtyard gives a unique magical atmosphere. The naturally lit extensive courtyard is surrounded by glass walls and has a beamed ceiling. It can be used throughout the entire year and is designed to host receptions, dinners, conventions, art exhibitions and coffee breaks during conventions and conferences.

The courtyard is encompassed by variety of seminar rooms of varying shapes and sizes. It offers the participants of the seminar the ideal place to relax. The nearby kitchen is well equipped and provides the courtyard with a range of catering options, from a cup of coffee to a three course meal. Hadarim Patio is the suitable hall for **VIP Private Dining Area Luncheon** alongside **Press Center** in Hadarim Patio 3.

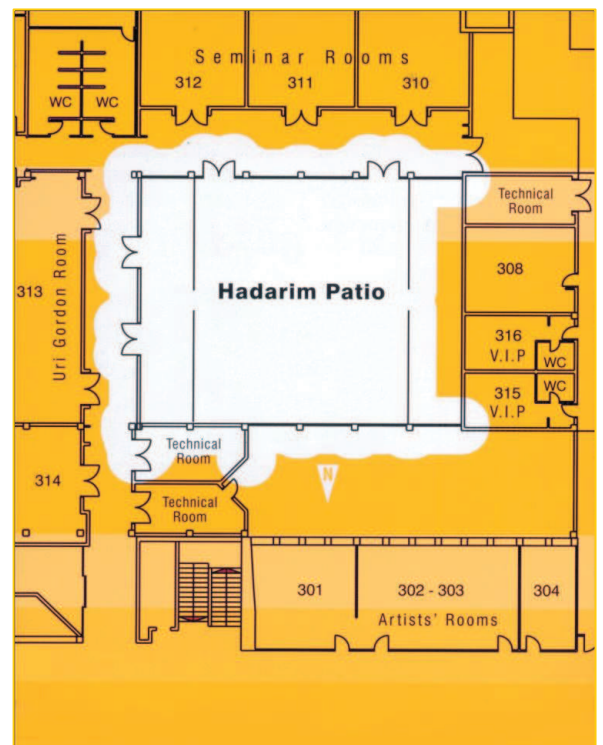

The Seminar Rooms (301 – 314) of the Convention Centre-ICC are designed for seminars, lectures and a variety of small events. The rooms are suitable for **Technical Sessions, Committee Meeting Rooms, IAF President Office, IISL President Office, IAA President Office, IAF Executive Director Office, IPC Co-Chairs Office, IAF Secretariat Office, IAA Secretariat Office and Speaker Preparation Room.**

The rooms are equipped with moveable chairs, integrated presentation boards, portable flip boards, audio-visual equipment and international telephone lines.
