PRESS RELEASE – 4 X 4 ARMORED VEHICLE PROTECTION – PRELIMINARY STAGE

1. Tender No. 8-2014 is hereby published for a feasibility study of vehicle importers combined with protection manufacturers for the acquisition and maintenance of armored 4 x 4 vehicles at an inclusive weight of up to 3,500 kgs
2. The tender shall be conducted via a preliminary selection stage (in two stages).
3. The tender is designed for the ongoing acquisition and maintenance of armored 4 x 4 vehicles in accordance with/ the complete technical specification to be delivered during the course of Stage B of the tender to the bidders who have passed the conditions of the preliminary selection stage.
4. An estimate for the acquisition of the vehicles totals about 30 vehicles for the years 2014 – 2016.
5. Potential bidders are invited to submit the following documents, for the purpose of examining the bidder and its compliance with the threshold conditions, for the purpose of determining the final list of bidders.
6. The proffered vehicles are required to comply with the following requirements:
 - 6.1 The Ministry of Transport specification for change of structure and protective installations in vehicles.
 - 6.2 A Demonstration of Anti-Bullet Vehicle Protection – IDF Standard (Quality Trial) No. 11740000126 latest edition.
 - 6.3 Anti-bullet Vehicle Protection (hermetic protection) - IDF Standard (Quality Trial) No. 11740000126 latest edition.
 - 6.4 Multi-layer Protective Windshields - IDF Standard (Quality Trial) No. 11740000126 latest edition.
 - 6.5 The Ministry of Transport's complete regulations.
7. The Tenders Committee shall select the bids summon the bidders who have complied with the above-mentioned requirements and send them the tender documents included in the "reserved" part (Part B of the tender).
8. The tender editor may prescribe in the second part of the tender, in the tender documents, additional threshold conditions that were not prescribed in the first part of the tender.
9. To receive the brochure for Stage A of the tender, containing a specification of the particulars required for the preliminary stage, apply to the Government Vehicle Administration offices in Jerusalem, 12 Beit HaDefus St., Givat Shaul, Jerusalem 5th floor to Mr. Moreno Barkai, Sunday to Thursday from 08:00 to 16:00 (excluding eves of festivals, festivals and intermediate days of festivals).

11. Bids in the tender shall be submitted in a sealed envelope without any of the bidder's identifying particulars. Only the Tender number shall be written on the envelopes. The envelopes shall be placed in the Tenders box at the Government Vehicle Administration, **before 20.11.2014 at 12:00 pm.**
