Re: Tender 78/2014 - Supply of multi-threat body armor for patrol officers

Update no. 9

I would like to update the above tender and clarify as follows:

1. You can present a quality assurance arrangement for the production of body armor / levels of protection also according to establishment ISO9001 and not just according to ISO9002: 2008, which was defined in the tender and specifications. (Sections 5.3 and 14.1.1 to the tender and Sections 2.13, and 13.2 in the specification).
2. Section 17.2.2 in the tender, the reference for a weighted mark passed, refers to an experiment of comfortable features and functions and not for quality components.
3. Section 4.3.2.2 and in Appendix 7 in the specification, net information are defined for sweat volatilize which is required to sow in the inside part of the armors mantle. The specified net in the specifications was defined as suitable by the Israeli Police. In case a proposer is interested to offer a different solution for sweat volatilize, he shall attach to his offer and to the examples of the body armor submitted, the technical data of the solution including weight, thickness and pressure contraction rate, and COC from the manufacturer. It is clarified that body armor examples that include the solution for sweat volatilize, will also be examined for comfortable features in convenience with the test stages as part of the steps in the way of determining the winner, which is defined in Section 17 of the tender and the proposal will be considered accordingly.

In any case, the Israeli Police reserves the right to require from a relevant bidder to sow in the body armor that are manufactured for the Israel Police the net that is defined in the specification at no extra cost, and in this case, may need further experimentation for the comfortable features and functionality in accordance with the professional judgment in the Israeli Police

4. Section 17.1.3. in the tender, the Israel Police reserves the right to experiment the comfortable features and functionality also for armor that have not been rated among the five cheapest armors and to consider all of the quality features of the offer for rating the proposer and to consider them in the process of determining the winner, by the Israeli Polices determination.
