

State of Israel – Israel National Digital Ministry – Government Teleprocessing Authority

Public Tender no. 4/21 – for the supply of an accessibility system for adapting government websites for people with disabilities, for the Israel National Digital Ministry – Government Teleprocessing Authority

1. The Israel National Digital Ministry – Government Teleprocessing Authority (henceforth “the Ministry”) is requesting bids for the supply of an accessibility system for adapting government websites for people with disabilities, in accordance with the needs of the ministry, based on the provisions of the tender documents, and in particular specifications about the content of the services (Chapter 2 of the tender documents).
2. The tender documents can be downloaded from the website of the Government Procurement Administration at <https://mr.gov.il/ilgstorefront/he/search/?s=tender>
3. The period of the contract is for three years, in accordance with the agreement attached to the TENDER . The Ministry is permitted to extend the contract period for additional periods, for a total of up to three additional years as per the provisions of the agreement.
4. Below is a summary of the threshold conditions for participation in the tender (the full and binding conditions are spelled out in the tender documents):
 - 4.1.1 The bidder is a manufacturer of the system he is offering (henceforth: “the system being offered), or alternatively, a licensed supplier of a manufacturer of the system being offered in Israel.
 - 4.1.2 The bidder has at least 10 active customers, with at least 5 of them in Israel, who use the system being offered and use it to perform manual and automatic adaptations for internet applications.
 - 4.1.3 The model of the accessibility menu of the system being offered has been integrated into at least 100 internet applications, whether in Israel or abroad.
 - 4.2 Summary of the general preconditions:
 - 4.2.1 The bidder must be a corporation registered in Israel.
 - 4.2.2 The bidder is in possession of any certificate and/or license and/or licensing and/or permit required pursuant to any law, and is listed in every registry conducted pursuant to any law and that is related to the subject of the contract,
 - 4.2.3 The bidder is in possession of valid authorizations in his name, pursuant to the Public Bodies Transactions Law, 5736 – 1976, and meets the conditions and provisions required by this law.
 - 4.2.4 The bidder has not been convicted of fiscal offenses, or of additional offenses detailed in Chapter 1 of the tender documents, unless the statute of limitations has expired.
 - 4.2.5 The bidder does not have a warning in the reviewed financial reports for the past two tax years regarding the corporation’s continued existence as a “going concern.”
 - 4.2.6 The bidder has attached a deposit for the bid in the sum of 75,000 shekels, as specified in the tender documents.

These replies and clarifications will constitute an integral part of the tender documents.

The Ministry reserves the right to publish changes and clarifications to the tender documents, even if they do not arise from the clarification questions received from the bidders, up to a reasonable time before the final date for submitting bids.
6. Submitting bids: Bids should be submitted, in Hebrew, to the Ministry’s tenders box, on the ground floor of the E-Government Building, 1 Nethanel Lorch St., Jerusalem, no later than June 28, 2021 (18th of Tammuz 5781) at 2 P.M. It is clarified that bids should not be sent by post. The Tenders Committee will not discuss any bid that was not found in the tenders box on the final date for submitting bids.
