
## Central Tender No. 01-2022 on the Subject of Adding Services to the **Government Digital Marketplace – Version 2**

**Tender Administrator Clarifications and Instructions** 

Greetings,

- On the 16<sup>th</sup> of June 2022, the Government Procurement Administration (hereinafter: "the 1. Tender Administrator") published Central Tender 01-2022 on the Subject of Adding Services to the Government Digital Marketplace in the Cloud (hereinafter: "the Tender"), as part of the "Nimbus Project" (tier 5 of the project).
- By the deadline for submitting clarification questions, over 1,000 question and comments 2. were received, from dozens of different entities. The questions and comments were reviewed by the Tender Administrator and updates were made to the Tender documents.
- We hereby publish the updated Tender documents and the Tender Administrator answers to 3. the clarification questions and comments.
- Please note the following clarifications and instructions regarding the Tender process: 4.
  - 4.1. <u>Bidders' conference</u> <u>additional</u> bidders' conferences will be held on <u>October 19</u>, 2022:
    - 4.1.1. The conference in the Hebrew language will take place at 10:00 (Israel Standard Time) - press here for registration.
    - 4.1.2. The conference in the English language will take place at 18:00 (Israel Standard Time) – press here for registration.
    - 4.1.3. There is no obligation to attend the conference.
  - 4.2. Clarification questions Additional clarification questions and comments may be submitted according to the following instructions:
    - 4.2.1. Clarification questions and comments regarding the Tender are to be submitted **only** through a dedicated system using the following link.
    - 4.2.2. Questions and comments may be submitted in the Hebrew or English languages.







4.2.3. Each Bidder may submit a maximum of 20 questions and comments.

## 4.2.4. <u>The deadline for submitting additional clarification questions</u> <u>and comments is October 27, 2022 at 23:59 (Israel Standard</u> <u>Time)</u>.

## 4.3. Submission of bids:

4.3.1. Bids for the Tender are to be submitted through an online bidding system. For instructions on how to submit bids, please refer to the document named "Bids Submission Guide" which is published on the <u>Tender Page</u>.

## 4.3.2. <u>The updated Closing Date is set for December 15, 2022 at 17:00</u> (Israel Standard Time).

4.4. <u>Registration for Distribution list</u> – instructions on how to register for the distribution list, as stated in section 1.6.2.1 of the Tender documents, are to published separately.
