	A	The Tender Committee hereby clarifies that the Pre-Qualification Submission may be executed in counterparts solely for signature purposes, provided that the submission executed by each Member is otherwise identical in all respects, and all such counterparts, taken together, shall constitute one and the same Pre-Qualification Submission. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Tender Committee rejects the request to submit signatures that are not affixed in wet ink.	
2.	Q	The Tender Committee was requested to clarify whether the EPC Expert is required to submit Pre-Qualification Form “5” (Public Entities Transactions Law Affidavit).	Section 3.5 and Pre-Qualification Form “5”
	A	Yes, the EPC Expert is required to submit Pre-Qualification Form “5” (Public Entities Transactions Law Affidavit). Together with this Addendum #5, a PDF and an MS-Word format versions of the Pre-Qualification forms in Annex C, are published, including a revised Form “5”.
