Israel Tax Authority

A two-stage international public tender no. 12/2022 – for the purchase of a low energy, dual view X-ray luggage scanner, and for the receipt of repair and maintenance service for a period of up to 10 years after the conclusion of the first year of warranty.

1. The Israel Tax Authority (henceforth: the Inviter) is issuing an international public tender for the receipt of bids for the purchase of a low energy, dual view X-ray luggage scanner, and for the receipt of repair and maintenance services for the device for a period of up to 10 years after the conclusion of the first year of warranty (henceforth the Tender).
2. The period of the contract with the winning bidder will begin on the date of the signing by both parties of the contract agreement attached to the tender documents, until the conclusion of the year of warranty of the system, and will end after the conclusion of the year of warranty, with the Inviter having the option of extending it on a yearly basis for a total of up to 10 years.
3. The bidder's offer will be submitted in Hebrew only.
4. The bidder must meet the following preconditions and must attach to its bid the documents proving its ability to meet them, as a condition for its participation in the tender:
 - 4.1 The bidder must present all the authorizations and affidavits required, pursuant to the Public Bodies Transactions Law, 5736 – 1976 (a legal entity that is not incorporated according to the laws of the State of Israel will attach parallel authorizations according to its country's laws, providing that they exist).
 - 4.2 If the bidder is a corporation, it must present authorization of registration in a registry conducted according to law for corporations of its type, as well as the authorization of an attorney.

4.3 The bidder must submit, along with its bid, a guarantee from a bank in Israel or an Israeli insurance company. The guarantee will be in the sum of 32,000 shekels payable to the Finance Ministry - Israel Tax Authority, and valid for 6 months after the final day for submitting bids in the tender, namely, until November 17, 2022.

5. Professional preconditions

5.1 The bidder is a manufacturer of low energy, dual view X-ray luggage scanners, which has produced and supplied a minimum of 10 such luggage scanners between 2017 and 2022.

5.2 In the course of the past three years (2019-2022) the bidder has had a luggage scanner system operating in an active site for a minimum of one consecutive year.

5.3 The bidder has an agent in Israel.

5.4 The bidder or someone on its behalf has experience of a minimum of two years between 2018 and 2022 in providing repair and maintenance services for a luggage scanner system.

5.5 The bidder must attach to its bid each one of the documents as part of the tender documents, including a copy of a permit to deal with radiation systems and any license required according to any law for the required system.

6. The bidder must meet all the additional preconditions and all the requirements as specified in the tender.

8. The bids should be inserted into the tenders box located at the Israel Tax Authority, 5 Bank Israel Street, Jerusalem, 1 Generi Building, 3rd floor, next to Room 3531, by November 17, 2022 at 1 P.M. The bid will be submitted in a signed and sealed envelope in two copies. Only the name and number of the tender

should be written on the envelope. A bid that is not found in the tenders box on the abovementioned date will not be discussed.

9. The Inviter is permitted not to accept any of the bids that are submitted and/or to cancel the tender, including for budgetary reasons.

10. The winner of the tender will be required to sign an agreement in the format of the agreement attached to the tender documents.

11. The full tender documents can be downloaded from the website of the Government Procurement Administration in the Accountant General Department, at www.mr.gov.il

12. Any change in the tender documents will be posted on the government website. The bidders are required to remain updated and to keep track of information on the website regarding the tender.

13. In the event of a contradiction between the directives of this notice and those of the tender documents, the tender documents will take precedence.

14. The Inviter is not required to accept the lowest bid or any other bid. The Inviter reserves the right to request clarifications from the bidders. The Inviter is permitted not to consider any bid that is unreasonable or incomplete or does not meet the requirements in the tender. The Inviter is permitted not to accept any of the bids submitted and/or to cancel the tender.
