3. Please note that there is a possibility that the Tender Process will include a 2<sup>nd</sup> Tender Stage within which the two Bidders who were awarded the highest final score at the 1<sup>st</sup> Tender Stage, will be obliged to complete financial closing and submit Best & Final Bids.

Please note that according to the Invitation for Bids, the Unsuccessful Best & Final Bidder may be entitled to a monetary compensation for its participation in the Tender Process, out of which a specified amount has been designated by the Tender Committee for the Arranger of that Unsuccessful Best & Final Bidder, which will be payable if the Arranger has submitted, during the questions submission process, its comprehensive and exhaustive comments, at the Tender Committee's discretion, to the Tender Documents.
5. Currently, the questions submission deadline as part of the Tender Process is April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
6. It is hereby emphasized that the Tender Committee does not undertake to issue the potential finance providers any future Addenda to the Tender Documents.
