Two-Stage International Public Tender No. 5/2024

For Supplying and Installing an Active GPS-Based System for Electronic Seals to Monitor and Supervise (Online) Shipping Container and Operationally Leased Truck Movement

1. The Israel Tax Authority (“the Client”) for **supplying and installing an active GPS-based system for electronic seals to monitor and supervise (online) the movement of shipping containers and operationally leased trucks (“the Tender”)**.
2. The contracting period with the winning bidder will be from the date the contracting agreement enclosed with the Tender documents is signed by both parties until the end of a year or part of it. The Client reserves the option to extend the contracting period by increments of one year (or part of it) for a maximum of five years collectively.
3. Bidders must meet the qualifying requirements below and enclose supporting documents to that effect along with their bid as a precondition for participating in the Tender.
 - 3.1. Bidders must provide the confirmations required under the Public Bodies Transactions Law of 1976 (legal entities not incorporated under Israeli law must enclose equivalent confirmations under the law in their location, insofar as they exist).
 - 3.2. Bidders must submit a guarantee from an Israeli bank or an Israeli insurance company for ILS 55,000 to the order of the Ministry of Finance – the Israel Tax Authority. The expiry date must be 12 months after the bid submission deadline (10:00 AM on 28 September 2025).
4. Bidders must fully meet all additional qualifying requirements as detailed in the Tender.
5. A tour for suppliers will take place at the Haifa Port and Haifa Tracking Site on Shemen Beach in Haifa on 25 July 2024 at 10:00 AM. **Participation in the tour is mandatory. Bids from bidders/representatives on their behalf who do not participate in the tour will be disqualified outright. Due to security and safety guidelines for entering these facilities, participating in the supplier conference requires coordinating arrival and receiving permission in advance from the Ministry representative by calling: 050-8479998.**
6. **Clarifying questions** can be sent in writing only to the tender committee coordinator, Ms. Ruth Sinai, **before 15 August 2024 at 3:00 PM** by fax at 02-6668252 or by email at Ruths@taxes.gov.il
7. Bids must be submitted twice in sealed and signed packages. Only the Tender name and number can be on the envelope. Bids that are not in the Tender box on the aforementioned date will not be considered.
8. The winning bidder will be required to sign an agreement as outlined in the agreement enclosed in the Tender documents.
9. The full Tender documents can be downloaded from the website of the Director of Government Procurement in the Accountant General’s Division at www.mr.gov.il

10. Any changes to the Tender documents will be published on the government website. Bidders are required to stay updated and follow publications regarding the Tender on the website.
11. The Client is not required to accept the lowest bid or any other bid. The Client reserves the right to ask for additional clarifications from bidders. The Client is entitled to disregard any bid that is unreasonable, lacking, or does not meet Tender requirements. The Client is entitled not to accept any of the bids submitted and/or cancel the Tender, including for budget reasons. The Client reserves the right to select a first and second qualifier. In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this advertisement and the provisions of the Tender documents, the Tender documents shall prevail.
